Schedule of 2-Year JD Programme with Civil Law LLB (as at 8 November 2021)

For the 2-Year JD, the total modular credits (MC) of <u>91-96 MC</u> will have to be completed. Each 4MC compulsory module is 36 contact hours. A 5MC elective module is 36 contact hours. All 8MC compulsory and elective modules are 72 contact hours. An intensive elective module, designated as 4MC and taught over 3 weeks by visiting professors, is 27 contact hours.
